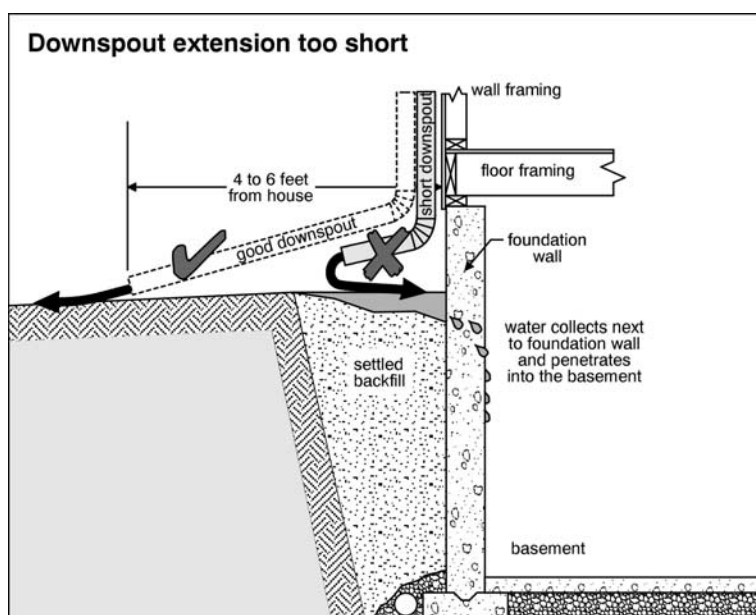
## Inspection Picture of the Month:

**Good drainage is important, but this guy got a little carried away...**

Inspectors always talk about the importance of pushing your downspouts out away from your home, and ensuring good landscaping and drainage. This guy took things to heart.



He had over 20' extensions installed on every downspout around the home. Granted that the lot was pretty flat, and drainage was a little bit of an issue, but this might be a little overkill.



Downspouts should extend 4-6 feet away from the house foundation, combined with good landscaping, to promote drainage away from the house and prevent any concerns with water collecting around the foundation.
